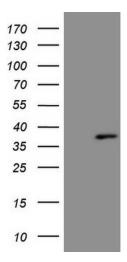

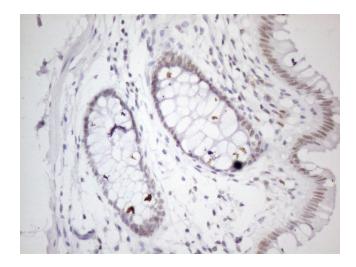

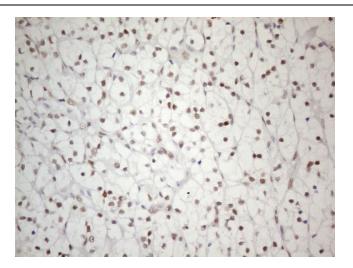


HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY TP53RK ([RC209748], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-TP53RK (1:2000). Positive lysates [LY403262] (100ug) and [LC403262] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
