Background: The Wilms tumor suppressor gene WT1 appears to play a role in both transcriptional and

posttranscriptional regulation of certain cellular genes. This gene encodes a WT1-associating protein, which is a ubiquitously expressed nuclear protein. Like WT1 protein, this protein is localized throughout the nucleoplasm as well as in speckles and partially colocalizes with splicing factors. Alternative splicing of this gene results in several transcript variants encoding











HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY WTAP ([RC209632], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-WTAP (1:2000). Positive lysates [LY417661] (100ug) and [LC417661] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.














