




Protein Pathways: Endocytosis

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY RAB11FIP4 (Cat# [RC210877], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-RAB11FIP4 (Cat# [TA808377])(1:2000). Positive lysates [LY409875] (100ug) and [LC409875] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
