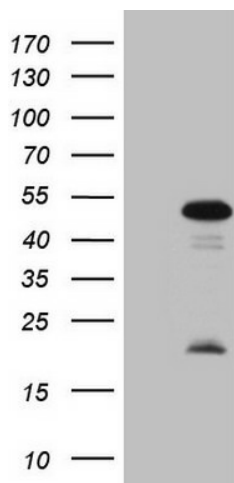

Studies in mice suggest that this protein may be a regulator of tendon development. Two transcript variants encoding the same protein have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jun 2011]

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY MKX ([RC206923], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-MKX (1:2000). Positive lysates [LY406487] (100ug) and [LC406487] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
