

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY CENPQ (Cat# [RC201897], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CENPQ (Cat# [TA808586])(1:2000). Positive lysates [LY413285] (100ug) and [LC413285] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
