**Background:** The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the WD-repeat family of regulatory proteins

and may be involved in normal development of the peripheral and central nervous system. The encoded protein is part of the nuclear pore complex and is anchored there by NDC1. Defects in this gene are a cause of achalasia-addisonianism-alacrima syndrome (AAAS), also called triple-A syndrome or Allgrove syndrome. Two transcript variants encoding different

isoforms have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Mar 2010]











Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (30 ug per lane) of wild-type HeLa cells (WT) and AAAS-Knockdown HeLa cells (KD) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-AAAS monoclonal antibody [TA808612] (1:5000). Then the blotted membrane was stripped and reprobed with anti-HSP90AA1 antibody as a loading control.




HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY AAAS (Cat# [RC200154], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-AAAS (Cat# [TA808612])(1:2000). Positive lysates [LY402460] (100ug) and [LC402460] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.






