involved in vesicle trafficking. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]



HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY VAPB ([RC200517], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-VAPB (1:2000). Positive lysates [LY401498] (100ug) and [LC401498] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
