
Background:

CIAPIN1 is a cytokine-induced inhibitor of apoptosis with no relation to apoptosis regulatory molecules of the BCL2 (MIM 151430) or CASP (see MIM 147678) families. Expression of CIAPIN1 is dependent on growth factor stimulation (Shibayama et al., 2004 [PubMed 14970183]). [supplied by OMIM, Mar 2008]. 

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY CIAPIN1 ([RC209626], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CIAPIN1 (1:2000). Positive lysates [LY412554] (100ug) and [LC412554] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Immunohistochemical staining of paraffinembedded Human tonsil within the normal limits using anti-CIAPIN1 mouse monoclonal antibody. Heat-induced epitope retrieval by EDTA solution buffer pH 8.0 at 120°C for 3 min.
