Background: The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the calcium channel beta subunit family. It plays

an important role in the calcium channel by modulating G protein inhibition, increasing peak calcium current, controlling the alpha-1 subunit membrane targeting and shifting the voltage dependence of activation and inactivation. Alternative splicing occurs at this locus and three transcript variants encoding three distinct isoforms have been identified. [provided by





HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY CACNB1 (Cat# [RC217910], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-CACNB1 (1:2000) (Cat# [TA809369]). Positive lysates [LY403703] (100ug) and [LC403703] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
