Background: This gene encodes a protein that contains a RUN domain, FYVE-type zinc finger domain and

Golgi dynamics (GOLD) domain. The encoded protein plays a role in microtubule plus end-directed transport of autophagic vesicles through interactions with the small GTPase Rab7, phosphatidylinositol-3-phosphate (PI3P) and the autophagosome marker LC3. Mutations in this gene are a cause of autosomal recessive congenital cataract-2 (CATC2). [provided by



HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY FYCO1 (Cat# [RC215323], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-FYCO1 (Cat# TA809860)(1:2000). Positive lysates [LY411258] (100ug) and [LC411258] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
