differentiation of epidermal tissue. Mutations in some of the genes targeted by this transcript



HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY PLAC2 ([RC207313], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-PLAC2 (1:2000). Positive lysates [LY407086] (100ug) and [LC407086] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
