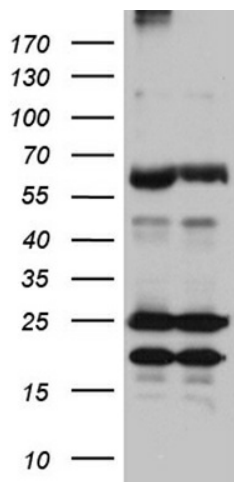

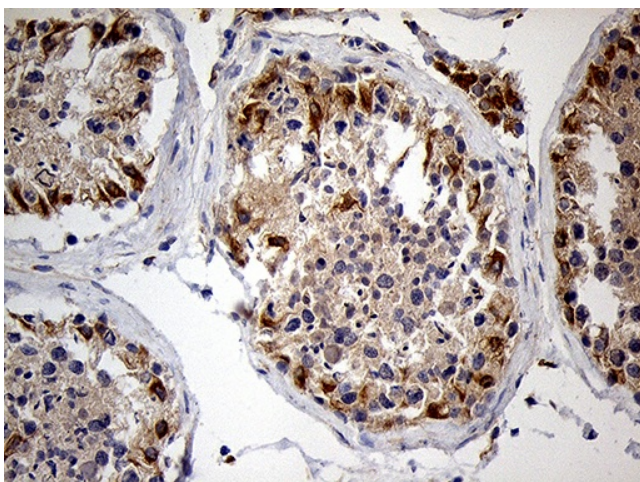

Background:	The protein encoded by this gene is a zinc finger protein containing a KRAB domain. Studies in mouse suggest that this protein may function as a transcriptional repressor. Mutations in this gene have been associated with transient neonatal diabetes mellitus type 1 (TNDM1). [provided by RefSeq, Sep 2009]

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY ZFP57 (Cat# [RC229273], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-ZFP57 (Cat# [TA811579])(1:2000). Positive lysates [LY432292] (100ug) and [LC432292] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Immunohistochemical staining of paraffin-embedded Human testis tissue within the normal limits using anti-ZFP57 mouse monoclonal antibody. Heat-induced epitope retrieval by EDTA solution buffer pH 8.0 at 120°C for 3 min.
