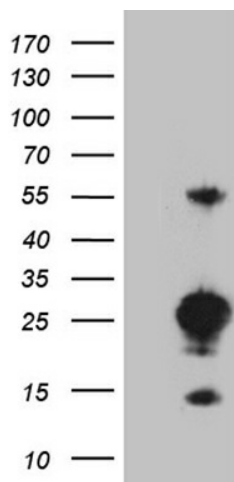

HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY MED9 ([RC211226], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-MED9. Positive lysates [LY413384] (100ug) and [LC413384] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
