



HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY DBN1 (Cat# [RC200372], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-DBN1 (Cat# TA812128). Positive lysates [LY418021] (100ug) and [LC418021] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.




Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from SHSY-5Y cell line by using anti-DBN1 monoclonal antibody (1:500).


