disrupt intestinal development and can cause early onset inflammatory bowel disease and intestinal atresia. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by



HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY TTC7A ([RC217177], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-TTC7A (1:2000). Positive lysates [LY412463] (100ug) and [LC412463] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.
