disrupt intestinal development and can cause early onset inflammatory bowel disease and intestinal atresia. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by





HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Cat# [PS100001], Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY TTC7A (Cat# [RC217177], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-TTC7A(Cat# [TA812302]). Positive lysates [LY412463] (100ug) and [LC412463] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.



Western blot analysis of extracts (35ug) from cell lines by using anti-TTC7A monoclonal antibody (1:500).
