Background: Natural killer (NK) cells are a distinct lineage of lymphocytes that mediate cytotoxic activity

and secrete cytokines upon immune stimulation. Several genes of the C-type lectin superfamily, including members of the NKG2 family, are expressed by NK cells and may be involved in the regulation of NK cell function. KLRD1 (CD94) is an antigen preferentially expressed on NK cells and is classified as a type II membrane protein because it has an external C terminus. Three transcript variants encoding two different isoforms have been

found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]


