**Summary:** The encoded protein is a regulatory subunit of the cAMP-dependent protein kinase (PKA)

complex, which is responsible for transducing most of the cAMP signals in eukaryotic cells. The inactive PKA complex contains two regulatory and two catalytic subunits. Binding of cAMP dissociates the complex, allowing monomeric catalytic subunits to phosphorylate cytosolic proteins or induce gene expression in the nucleus. Several transcript variants encoding the same protein have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Sep 2015]

# Performance Guaranteed:

OriGene guarantees that the sequences in the shRNA expression cassettes are verified to correspond to the target gene with 100% identity. One of the four constructs at minimum are guaranteed to produce 70% or more gene expression knock-down provided a minimum transfection efficiency of 80% is achieved. Western Blot data is recommended over qPCR to evaluate the silencing effect of the shRNA constructs 72 hrs post transfection. To properly assess knockdown, the gene expression level from the included scramble control vector must be used in comparison with the target-specific shRNA transfected samples.

For non-conforming shRNA, requests for replacement product must be made within ninety (90) days from the date of delivery of the shRNA kit.
