Summary:	This gene encodes a member of the tumor necrosis factor superfamily of proteins. The encoded receptor has been shown to bind to the ligand TRAIL (tumor necrosis factor-related apoptosis-inducing ligand), but to have no signaling capacity. This gene shows elevated expression in mice with diet-induced fatty liver disease. This gene and other family members are present in a gene cluster on chromosome 7. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by RefSeq, Apr 2015]

OriGene guarantees that the sequences in the shRNA expression cassettes are verified to correspond to the target gene with 100% identity. One of the four constructs at minimum are guaranteed to produce 70% or more gene expression knock-down provided a minimum transfection efficiency of 80% is achieved. Western Blot data is recommended over qPCR to evaluate the silencing effect of the shRNA constructs 72 hrs post transfection. To properly assess knockdown, the gene expression level from the included scramble control vector must be used in comparison with the target-specific shRNA transfected samples.

For non-conforming shRNA, requests for replacement product must be made within ninety (90) days from the date of delivery of the shRNA kit.
