<b>Summary:</b>	This gene encodes a member of the ATPase inhibitor family of proteins. This protein has been shown to negatively regulate the ATP hydrolysis activity of the F1Fo-ATPase. Knockdown of this gene is associated with reduced heme synthesis in differentiating erythroid cells. Misregulation of this gene has been found to lead to increased aerobic glycolysis in mouse cancer cells, while high expression levels of this gene have been correlated with gastric and liver cancer severity in human patients. A pseudogene of this gene has been identified. [provided by RefSeq, Apr 2015]

OriGene guarantees that the sequences in the shRNA expression cassettes are verified to correspond to the target gene with 100% identity. One of the four constructs at minimum are guaranteed to produce 70% or more gene expression knock-down provided a minimum transfection efficiency of 80% is achieved. Western Blot data is recommended over qPCR to evaluate the silencing effect of the shRNA constructs 72 hrs post transfection. To properly assess knockdown, the gene expression level from the included scramble control vector must be used in comparison with the target-specific shRNA transfected samples.

For non-conforming shRNA, requests for replacement product must be made within ninety (90) days from the date of delivery of the shRNA kit.
