Summary: This gene encodes a member of the reticulon family, a large group of membrane-bound

proteins that primarily localize to the endoplasmic reticulum with a small subpopulation at the cell surface. These proteins play roles in endocytosis, exocytosis, trafficking and neuronal outgrowth. Proteins belonging to this family are characterized by a carboxy-terminal reticulon homology domain that consists of a small hydrophilic loop flanked by hydrophobic regions. In rat, this protein has been shown to interact with two members of the synaptic adhesion-

like molecule family, suggesting that it may function in trafficking of these proteins.

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Performance Guaranteed:

OriGene guarantees that the sequences in the shRNA expression cassettes are verified to correspond to the target gene with 100% identity. One of the four constructs at minimum are guaranteed to produce 70% or more gene expression knock-down provided a minimum transfection efficiency of 80% is achieved. Western Blot data is recommended over qPCR to evaluate the silencing effect of the shRNA constructs 72 hrs post transfection. To properly assess knockdown, the gene expression level from the included scramble control vector must be used in comparison with the target-specific shRNA transfected samples.

For non-conforming shRNA, requests for replacement product must be made within ninety (90) days from the date of delivery of the shRNA kit.
