
Summary: The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the serpin family of proteinase inhibitors.

Members of this family maintain homeostasis by neutralizing overexpressed proteinase activity through their function as suicide substrates. This protein inhibits the neutrophilderived proteinases neutrophil elastase, cathepsin G, and proteinase-3 and thus protects tissues from damage at inflammatory sites. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript



Linear correlations between plasma serpinB1 and insulin sensitivity index (SI) in 117 non-diabetic adult individuals. Both serpinB1 levels and SI are natural logs transformed. Pearson correlation coefficient (r) and the corresponding P values are shown. SerpinB1 was measured in plasma using ELISA with OriGene [TP302138] SERPINB1 protein as the standard. Coomassie blue staining of purified SERPINB1 protein (Cat# [TP302138]). The protein was produced from HEK293T cells transfected with SERPINB1 cDNA clone (Cat# [RC202138]) using MegaTran 2.0 (Cat# [TT210002]).
