

| Summary:         | This gene encodes a member of the class I fructose-bisphosphate aldolase protein family. The<br>encoded protein is a glycolytic enzyme that catalyzes the reversible conversion of fructose-1,6-<br>bisphosphate to glyceraldehyde 3-phosphate and dihydroxyacetone phosphate. Three<br>aldolase isozymes (A, B, and C), encoded by three different genes, are differentially expressed<br>during development. Mutations in this gene have been associated with Glycogen Storage<br>Disease XII, an autosomal recessive disorder associated with hemolytic anemia. Disruption of<br>this gene also plays a role in the progression of multiple types of cancers. Related<br>pseudogenes have been identified on chromosomes 3 and 10. [provided by RefSeq, Sep 2017] |
