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Summary: The product of this gene catalyzes the last step of the catecholamine biosynthesis pathway,


> which methylates norepinephrine to form epinephrine (adrenaline). The enzyme also has betacarboline 2N-methyltransferase activity. This gene is thought to play a key step in regulating epinephrine production. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been found for this gene.
