plays for instance a role in the incorporation of SLC11A2 into extracellular vesicles

(PubMed:27462458). More generally, plays a role in the extracellular transport of proteins


between cells through the release in the extracellular space of microvesicles

(PubMed:22315426). By participating to the ITCH-mediated ubiquitination and subsequent

degradation of NOTCH1, negatively regulates the NOTCH signaling pathway
