Summary: This gene encodes a member of the TGF-beta (transforming growth factor-beta) superfamily of


> proteins. The encoded preproprotein is proteolytically processed to generate a subunit of homodimeric and heterodimeric activin complexes. The heterodimeric complex may function in the inhibition of activin A signaling. Transgenic mice overexpressing this gene exhibit defects
