
Summary: Kallikreins are a subgroup of serine proteases having diverse physiological functions. Growing

evidence suggests that many kallikreins are implicated in carcinogenesis and some have potential as novel cancer and other disease biomarkers. This gene is one of the fifteen kallikrein subfamily members located in a cluster on chromosome 19. Alternate splicing and the use of alternate promoters results in multiple transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms

which are differentially expressed. [provided by RefSeq, Dec 2016]
