
Synonyms: A2LD1

**Summary:** The protein encoded by this gene aids in the proteolytic degradation of crosslinked fibrin by

breaking down isodipeptide L-gamma-glutamyl-L-epsilon-lysine, a byproduct of fibrin degradation. The reaction catalyzed by the encoded gamma-glutamylaminecyclotransferase produces 5-oxo-L-proline and a free alkylamine. Two transcript variants encoding the same

protein have been found for this gene.[provided by RefSeq, Aug 2010]
