Buffer: Lyophilized from a 0.2 um filtered solution of 20mM Tris-HCl, 150mM NACl, pH 8.0.

Endotoxin: Endotoxin level is < 0.1 ng/μg of protein (< 1 EU/μg)

Reconstitution Method: Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting. Dissolve the

lyophilized protein in ddH2O. It is not recommended to reconstitute a concentration less than 100 μ g/ml. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: Lyophilized protein should be stored at < -20°C, though stable at room temperature for 3

weeks. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-7°C for 2-7 days. Aliquots of

reconstituted samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.

Stability: Stable for at least 6 months from date of receipt under proper storage and handling

conditions.

INSL4 (NM_002195) Human Recombinant Protein - TP720733M

Summary: INSL4 encodes the insulin-like 4 protein, a member of the insulin superfamily. INSL4 encodes

a precursor that undergoes post-translational cleavage to produce 3 polypeptide chains, A-C, that form tertiary structures composed of either all three chains, or just the A and B chains.

Expression of INSL4 products occurs within the early placental cytotrophoblast and

syncytiotrophoblast. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008]
