Storage: Store at -20°C.

Stability: Stable for at least 6 months from date of receipt under proper storage and handling

conditions.

IFNW1 (NM_002177) Human Recombinant Protein - TP721113XL

Summary: The protein encoded by this gene is an interferon and possesses antiviral activity. The

encoded protein binds to the interferon alpha/beta receptor but not to the interferon gamma receptor. This intronless gene has several pseudogenes spread throughout the genome.
