Predicted MW: The protein has a predicted molecular mass of 49.9 kDa after removal of the signal

peptide. The apparent molecular mass of IL4RA-hFc is approximately 55-70 kDa due to

glycosylation.

Purity: The purity of the protein is greater than 95% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie

blue staining.

Reconstitution Method: Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8% trehalose is added as protectants

before lyophilization.

Storage: Store at -20°C to -80°C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not intended

for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing).

Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient temperature.

Stability: 12 months from date of despatch

Summary: This gene encodes the alpha chain of the interleukin-4 receptor, a type I transmembrane

protein that can bind interleukin 4 and interleukin 13 to regulate IgE production. The encoded protein also can bind interleukin 4 to promote differentiation of Th2 cells. A soluble form of the encoded protein can be produced by proteolysis of the membrane-bound protein, and this soluble form can inhibit IL4-mediated cell proliferation and IL5 upregulation by T-cells. Allelic variations in this gene have been associated with atopy, a condition that can manifest itself as allergic rhinitis, sinusitus, asthma, or eczema. Polymorphisms in this gene are also associated with resistance to human immunodeficiency virus type-1 infection. Alternate

splicing results in multiple transcript variants.
