## **Human IFNAR1 Protein, His Tag**

**Description:** Human IFNAR1 Protein, His Tag

**Predicted MW:** The protein has a predicted molecular mass of 48.0 kDa after removal of the signal

peptide. The apparent molecular mass of IFNAR1-His is approximately 70-100 kDa due to

glycosylation.

**Purity:** The purity of the protein is greater than 90% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie

blue staining.

**Reconstitution Method:** Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8% trehalose is added as protectants

before lyophilization.

Storage: Store at -20°C to -80°C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not intended

for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing).

Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient temperature.

**Stability:** 12 months from date of despatch

**Summary:** The protein encoded by this gene is a type I membrane protein that forms one of the two

chains of a receptor for interferons alpha and beta. Binding and activation of the receptor stimulates Janus protein kinases, which in turn phosphorylate several proteins, including STAT1 and STAT2. The protein belongs to the type II cytokine receptor family and functions as
