Predicted MW: The protein has a predicted molecular mass of 84.1kDa after removal of the signal

peptide. The apparent molecular mass of VEGFR2-His is approximately 130-250 kDa due to

glycosylation.

Purity: The purity of the protein is greater than 95% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie

blue staining.

Reconstitution Method: Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8% trehalose is added as protectants

before lyophilization.

Storage: Store at -20°C to -80°C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not intended

for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing).

Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient temperature.

Stability: 12 months from date of despatch

Summary: Vascular endothelial growth factor (VEGF) is a major growth factor for endothelial cells. This

gene encodes one of the two receptors of the VEGF. This receptor, known as kinase insert domain receptor, is a type III receptor tyrosine kinase. It functions as the main mediator of VEGF-induced endothelial proliferation, survival, migration, tubular morphogenesis and sprouting. The signalling and trafficking of this receptor are regulated by multiple factors, including Rab GTPase, P2Y purine nucleotide receptor, integrin alphaVbeta3, T-cell protein tyrosine phosphatase, etc.. Mutations of this gene are implicated in infantile capillary
