| Predicted MW: | The protein has a predicted molecular mass of 73.3 kDa after removal of the signal peptide. The apparent molecular mass of IFNAR1-hFc is approximately 100-130 kDa due to glycosylation. |
| Purity: | The purity of the protein is greater than 95% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining. |
| Reconstitution Method: | Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8% trehalose is added as protectants before lyophilization. |
| Storage: | Store at -20°C to -80°C for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not intended for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80°C (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing). Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient temperature. |
| Stability: | 12 months from date of despatch |
| Summary: | The protein encoded by this gene is a type I membrane protein that forms one of the two chains of a receptor for interferons alpha and beta. Binding and activation of the receptor stimulates Janus protein kinases, which in turn phosphorylate several proteins, including STAT1 and STAT2.
