Tag: His Tag (C-term)

Predicted MW: The protein has a calculated MW of 16.04 kDa. The protein migrates as 17 kDa under

reducing condition (SDS-PAGE analysis).

Purity: >98% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Buffer: The protein was lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution containing 1X PBS, pH 7.4.

Bioactivity: Measure by its ability to induce NFS-60 cells proliferation. The ED₅₀ for this effect is <85

pg/mL. The specific activity of recombinant mouse IL-3 is approximately >1x 10⁷ IU/mg.

Endotoxin: <0.1 EU per 1 μg of the protein by the LAL method.

Reconstitution Method: Centrifuge at 3000 rpm for 5 mins before opening. It is recommended to reconstitute the

lyophilized protein in sterile H_2O to a concentration not less than 100 μ g/mL and incubate the stock solution at room temperature for at least 20 mins to ensure sufficient re-dissolved.

Do Not Vortex! Vigorous shaking may impair the biological activity of the protein.

Applications: Cell culture

Storage: Lyophilized protein should be stored at -20°C for 1 year. Upon reconstitution, store at 2°C to

8°C for up to 1 week. Further dilute in a buffer containing a carrier protein or stabilizer (e.g. 0.1% BSA, 10%FBS, 5%HSA or 5% trehalose solution), protein aliquots should be stored at -

20°C or -80°C for 3-6 months. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.






Summary:

Interleukin-3 (IL-3) is a pleiotropic cytokine which can stimulates the survival, differentiation and proliferation of committed progenitor cells, including megakaryocyte, granulocyte-macrophage, erythroid, eosinophil, basophil and mast cell lineages. IL-3 also enhances phagocytosis and antibody-mediated cellular cytotoxicity. IL-3 binds to IL-3R (IL-3 receptor), which is composed of a unique α subunit (IL-3R α) and a common β -subunit (β c).
