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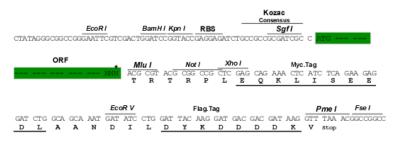
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## **Cloning Scheme:**

ORF Size: 210 bp

OTI Disclaimer: The molecular sequence of this clone can be viewed by clicking the "ORF Nucleotide

Sequence" link above. This sequence represents the NCBI reference after codon optimization for human cell expression, and retaining the same decoded protein sequence. The stop codon in the native sequence was removed to create the in-frame c-terminal fusion with a

Myc-DDK tag.

**Components:** The ORF clone is ion-exchange column purified and shipped in a 2D barcoded Matrix tube

containing 10ug of transfection-ready, dried plasmid DNA (reconstitute with 100 ul of water).

**Reconstitution Method:** 1. Centrifuge at 5,000xg for 5min.

2. Carefully open the tube and add 100ul of sterile water to dissolve the DNA.

3. Close the tube and incubate for 10 minutes at room temperature.

4. Briefly vortex the tube and then do a quick spin (less than 5000xg) to concentrate the liquid

at the bottom.

5. Store the suspended plasmid at -20°C. The DNA is stable for at least one year from date of

shipping when stored at -20°C.
